

Migros GolfCard – General Terms and Conditions

1. Becoming a member of Migros GolfCard

Anyone who wishes to become a holder of a Migros GolfCard should truthfully complete the membership form and send it to the following address:

By signing the membership form, you agree to the Migros GolfCard General Terms and Conditions in force.

The Migros GolfCard will be sent to you by post within five working days after full payment of the membership dues to the account indicated in the application form.

2. Conditions of Membership

Generally, anyone with a permission to play or an official handicap is eligible for the Migros GolfCard. Players currently taking courses to obtain a permission to play at any of our facilities may also apply for membership. The official conditions of admission of Migros Golf Courses apply to play in our facilities. For more information, please go to: www.golfparks.ch.

3. Handicap Management

Migros GolfCard member handicaps are managed based on the Handicap Regulations of the EGA (for more information, please go to: <http://www.golfparks.ch/de/migros-golfcard/mitgliedschaft/hcp-und-profilverwaltung>).

During registration, your address will be forwarded to Swiss Golf to issue your member card.

4. Rules and Etiquette

Migros GolfCard holders must follow the rules of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the rules of the individual golf courses and golf facilities as green-fee players. You can view the regulations and other information at www.golfparks.ch or obtain a copy on location if required.

5. Migros GolfCard

Cardholders receive their personal cards after paying the annual membership dues at the start of the season. The cards bear the following information:

surname, given name, ID number, play level (HCP) and year of validity.

All cardholders have the option to view their current HCP master data sheet at www.golfsuisse.ch/mygolfsuisse.

If you lose your card, a new card can be issued by paying a replacement fee of CHF 30.

6. Data Protection

Migros GolfCard handles the data collected in connection with membership with the utmost care and in accordance with the regulations of the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection.

By purchasing the Migros GolfCard, the member consents to the use of the corresponding data as well as additional data available to Migros GolfCard or from third parties, within the entire Migros Group for shopping cart analyses, personalised promotional campaigns and contacting customers. The Migros Group comprises: The Migros-Genossenschafts-Bund

(Federation of Migros Cooperatives), the Migros cooperatives, the retail stores belonging to Migros as well as the Migros service and production companies.

Data are only transmitted outside the Migros Group under strict, contractual data protection regulations to external service providers or third parties in Switzerland or abroad, to criminal authorities where required by law or when disclosure is necessary to the preservation and implementation of Migros' legitimate interests. The customer has the right to revoke its consent to advertising at any time.

7. Annual Dues

Annual dues always apply per calendar year and are independent of the date of joining or leaving. Refunds of any kind, including pro rated refunds, are barred. Current prices can be found at www.migros-golfcard.ch.

8. Termination and Renewal

The Migros GolfCard can be terminated by 30 November (postmark date) of each year, effective at the end of the year. If no written notice of termination is submitted by the aforementioned date, membership shall automatically be renewed for one year. Thereupon, the full annual membership dues shall be payable.

9. Exclusion/Rejection of Membership

Migros GolfCard reserves the right to refuse to grant membership or licence cards or to revoke them. In such cases, no justification shall be required on the part of Migros GolfCard.

10. Amendments

Customers expressly acknowledge that the GTCs are subject to changes that shall be communicated to them in a suitable form. The current GTCs can be consulted at www.migros-golfcard.ch.

11. Applicable Law/Jurisdiction

Swiss substantive law applies exclusively.

The exclusive place of jurisdiction is Otelfingen.
